**This chair features the unparalleled Goddard ball & claw foot, intaglio knee carving, and Newport shell crest rail.**



Among the many features, this class includes, are: patterns, templates, a plaster cast of the ball and claw foot, milled parts, making the slip seat, & applying the finish, etc. Videos of the demonstrations will be available. All applications will be followed by an interview including submission of photos of completed work. Upon acceptance to the class, the student will receive a list of required tools & materials.

This advanced level course is designed to increase hand tool skills by using an 18th century repertoire: carving tools, chisels, rasps, frame saw, & brace and bit. (A minimalistic tool kit) (Except for the lathe, there will be no power tool requirements.)

Once each month, Randy will demonstrate for the whole class. And then, during the month, each student will schedule two sessions for their own individual instruction. Rough milling of part blanks will be provided (and wood packages are available upon request)
